Good Samaritan legislation

The Leader of the State Opposition, Will Hodgman, has welcomed the State Labor Government's adoption of Liberal policy in relation to Good Samaritan legislation.

State Opposition Leader, Will Hodgman, has been pushing for legislative changes to provide legal certainty and protection to volunteers in our community, as part of the Fairer Tasmania policy he announced last year.

Tasmania had been one of only two States in Australia not to have this legislative protection in place.

Mr Hodgman said he was under no illusion that this move would in any way provide a solution to poverty in our community.

"But it is one small step that may make a difference to people in need," Mr Hodgman said.
