Government must act swiftly to help Cadbury workers

The Leader of the State Opposition, Will Hodgman, has called on the State Government to act swiftly to help workers affected by the restructuring at the Claremont Cadbury factory.

“While Cadburys’ additional investment in Tasmania is welcome, I am extremely concerned for the workers and families who will suffer because of this decision,” Mr Hodgman said.

“These job losses come at a time when many working families are struggling to make ends meet and the loss of an income will be a massive blow.

“The government must step in quickly to support and assist these workers and their families and help them to retrain and find new jobs.

“This is not a situation where the government can afford to be complacent,” Mr Hodgman said.
